

Learning Priorities

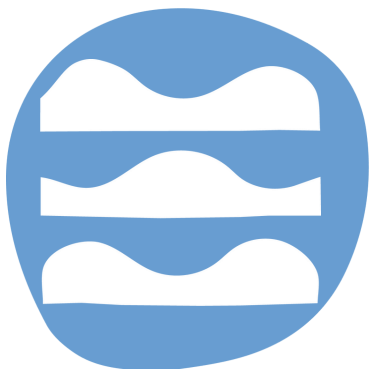


Whanaungatanga
